

INTRODUCTION

The Clinician's Workshop is a "train-the-trainer" program designed to teach recreation directors and youth sport administrators the fundamentals of conducting the Rutgers S.A.F.E.T.Y. Clinic – *Sports Awareness for Educating Today's Youth*™. The content for this award-winning program is based upon the *Minimum Standards for Volunteer Coaches' Safety Orientation and Training Skills Programs* (N.J.A.C. 5:52) developed by the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports.

The Clinician's Workshop is specifically designed for adult learners and will cover:

- S.A.F.E.T.Y. Clinic Curriculum
- Effective Teaching Techniques
- Administering the Clinic

Upon completing the workshop, instructor candidates must pass a self-study exam (minimum passing score = 90%) to become eligible to teach the clinic. Thereafter, Clinicians must teach the clinic at least once/year to retain their certification.

Note: If you previously attended the Clinician's Workshop but have not taught the Clinic within the past year, you must register as Option A.

Founded in 1983, the Youth Sports Research Council (YSRC) is a continuing education division of the Department of Exercise Science and Sport Studies at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey. The YSRC develops and disseminates information about the influence of organized sports on the physical and psychological development of children and adolescents.

Following the enactment of the *Little League Law* (2A:62A-6 et. seq.) on May 12, 1986, the YSRC combined efforts with the New Jersey Recreation and Park Association (NJRPA) to provide safety training for volunteer coaches. The *Little League Law* links civil immunity protection to attendance at a "safety orientation and training skills program."

Through the efforts of hundreds of volunteer Clinicians, more than 200,000 youth sport coaches have attended the Rutgers S.A.F.E.T.Y. Clinic and been provided with partial civil immunity protection under the law.
